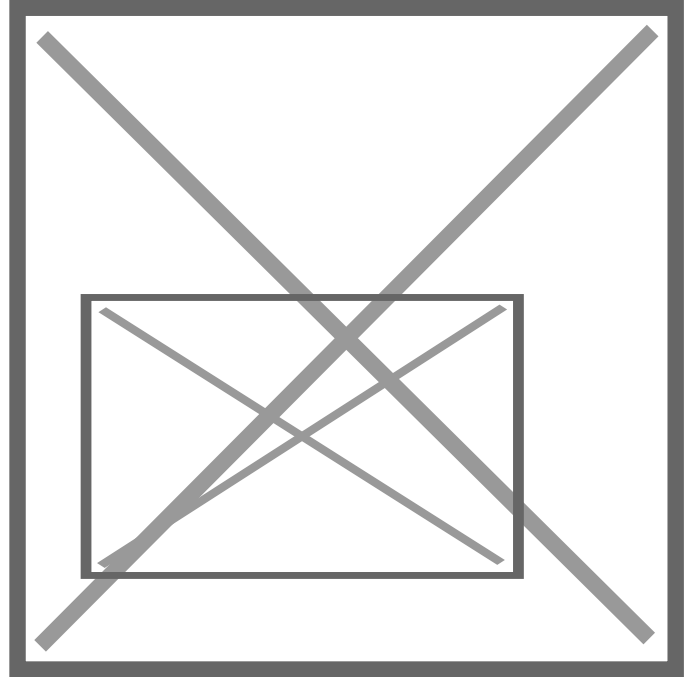


Intermountain thanks Booth Society
