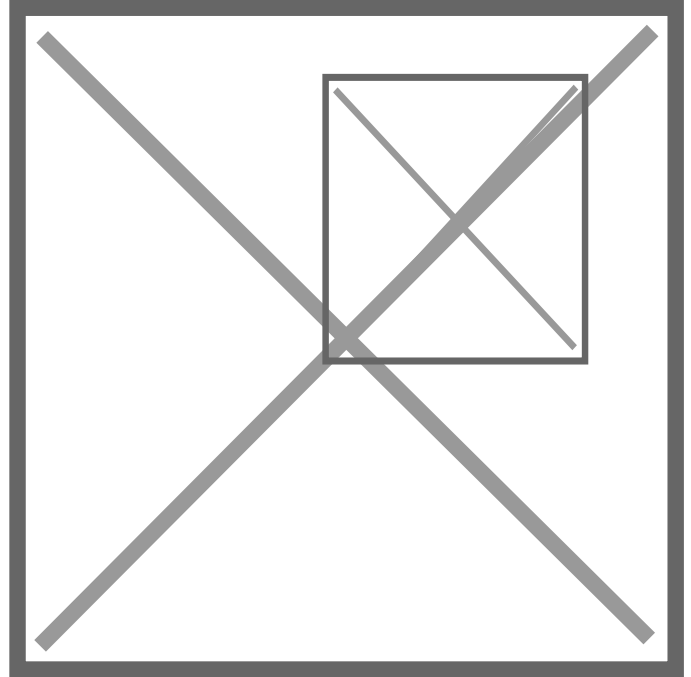


Kelly receives 'Others' award
