

Las Vegas Salvation Army serves veterans

March, The Salvation Army helped serve 579 veterans at the East Las Vegas Senior Community Center. The 500-plus volunteers participating included Salvation Army employees, University of Nevada Las Vegas students, Nellis Air Force Base personnel and many others. The Owens kitchen prepared a hot breakfast—a total of 500 meals (250 each day)—and the Army’s emergency disaster services canteen served a total of 700 cups of coffee and 300 cups of hot chocolate.
