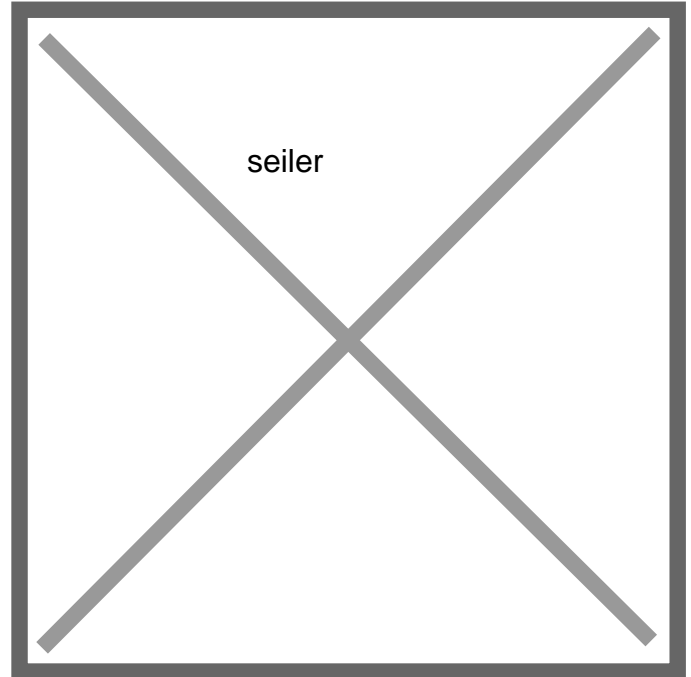


Seilers installed as Cascade leaders
